

**Extended Learning and Integrated Student Supports (ELISS) – 2020 COVID-19 Recovery Act
Desk Review Instrument and Feedback Report**

The State Educational Agency (SEA) is required to monitor the usage and allowability of funds provided to nonprofit corporations operating ELISS programs with funds provided through HB1043 the 2020 Covid-19 Recovery Act ([HB1043 Full Text](#)). Monitoring of the ELISS subgrantee’s program focuses on indicators across three (3) compliance categories: Program Implementation; Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic; and ELISS Services Received and Impact on Students.

Each compliance category is rated in the ELISS Desk Review Report (hereafter referred to as Report) as follows:
